General Information

What to Bring:

Please bring: instrument, music, Bible, towels and washcloths, soap, pillow, sheets and blanket or sleeping bag (If you are arriving by plane, we can provide linens for you.) clock, (**sorry, no clock radios**) laundry detergent (free washers and dryers available in each dorm) Dorm rooms are not air conditioned, so bringing a small fan is appropriate.

Please do not bring: electric guitars, radios, tape players, MP3 players, CD players, phones, TV's, electronic games or electronic devices. All reading material, pictures, and room décor items are subject to review by Csehy administration to determine appropriateness for the Csehy program.

Please be prepared: Please come with a selection you are prepared to play during your audition as well as additional music you would like to learn or work on. If you are working on a solo that has a piano accompaniment, please remember to bring the piano part with you in case you are asked to play that piece in a recital. Your current teacher may want to suggest some repertoire.

Dress Code:

The basic standard is modesty. The following guidelines should be helpful.

Daytime/casual: Shorts may not be higher than 2" above the top of the knee. Shirts must be long enough to stay tucked into pants or skirts during normal activity. Only spiritually edifying words and pictures or standard company logos are permitted on clothing.

Dinner/evening: Girls: dress pants, skirts/dresses should be knee length or longer (please, no mini skirts, spaghetti straps or strapless dresses)
Boys: pants (no jeans) collared shirts, ties optional; belts required if pants have loops.

Recitals/dress clothes:
Girls: skirts/dresses
Boys: dress pants, collared shirts, ties, jacket optional

Swimwear: Girls: one piece, discreet and opaque wet or dry—modesty can be enhanced with shorts or t-shirt worn over swimsuit
Boys: modest length (no racing style)

Special Events: Clothing for special days such as “Clash Day” and “Christmas in July” must meet the modesty standard, but feel free to be creative.

Concerts:	Girls: white blouse; full length black skirt or full-length, dressy, black pants; dark or black shoes
	Boys: white collared shirt, black bow tie, black dress pants, black socks, dark dress shoes, no jacket

Administration reserves the right to evaluate all dress to insure it conforms to Csehy standards
